# Our Tea Selection

# BLACK TEA-

Black tea is crafted to reveal the strongest and deepest flavours, they are more oxidised than other teas, so generally have an intense, richly aromatic and malty taste.

### **ENGLISH BREAKFAST**

Kolkata, India

A unique blend of 17 Assam teas, it has a full, malty flavour and a rich, dark colour. Can be served with or without milk.

# ENGLISH BREAKFAST DECAFFEINATED

Kolkata, India

A unique blend of two Assam teas.
This tea is very similar in flavour to our classic breakfast blend, however the caffeine has been stripped from the leaf before processing occurs.

## **EARL GREY**

Sri Lanka

A blend of Ceylon and Assam black teas flavoured with natural bergamot oil and decorated with blue flower. Smooth and balanced with floral notes

# FRENCH EARL GREY

China

A black tea flavoured with natural bergamot oil and decorated with rose petals for a floral aroma and flavour.

# KENILWORTH CEYLON

Nuwara Eliya, Sri Lanka

A high-grade Flowery Broken Orange Pekoe tea. This is a beautiful tea with a large strikingly black pine needle shaped leaf from the world-famous Kenilworth Estate. Bright, lively and beautifully smooth.

# GOPALDHARA 2ND FLUSH DARJEELING

Darjeeling, India

The tippy leaves produce a golden liquor with a lovely muscatel character. The smooth flavours are fruity, with honey notes and a satisfying mineral and citrus aftertaste.

# WHITE TEA-

White tea is the least oxidised of all teas, the young leaves and buds are picked and dried. This minimal processing and low oxidation results in some of the most delicate and freshest teas.

### WHITE POMEGRANATE

Fujian, China

This is a blended white tea with pomegranate arils, dragon fruit, lemongrass and dragon fruit pieces. It has a light, fruity, refreshing taste.

# GREEN TEA

Green tea has minimum processing which allows the fresh, green flavour of the leaves to be maintained, relatively low in caffeine and high in antioxidants.

# PINHEAD GUNPOWDER

Fujian, China

Its leaves are hand rolled into small pellets, this allows the tea to retain more of its flavour and aroma.

# JASMINE YIN HAO

Fujian, China

A top-grade jasmine green tea, the tea is naturally scented with jasmine flowers.

# KUKICHA SENCHA

Japan

Grown in Shizuoka, Japan by an award-winning producer. Kukicha consists of the stalk of the tea plant. Expect notes of ripe mango, rich umani flavours and a pleasant vegetal note.

# YUNNAN GREEN

Yunnan, China

It has a full bodied but mellow taste and has a lot of sweetness at the forefront of the taste.

# JAPANESE CHERRY

Japan

A Japanese sencha green tea blended with cherry and rose petals, it is a sweet fruity blend that can be enjoyed hot or as a cold infusion.

# OOLONG TEA-

Oolong is a partially oxidised tea predominately produced in China, it falls between green and black tea.

# ORANGE BLOSSOM OOLONG

Taiwan

A Taiwanese oolong tea blended with orange peel and orange oil. It has fresh citrus notes and floral aroma, an ideal alternative to Earl Grey.

# HERBAL INFUSIONS

They are the infusions of the leaves and stems of different herbs. They contain no additives or flavourings and are naturally caffeine free.

# LEMONGRASS & GINGER

England

A blend of cut lemongrass and ginger pieces. Full bodied, fresh, sweet citrus and fiery notes throughout.

# PEPPERMINT

Serbia

Whole leaf peppermint, full bodied, minty and fresh flavour.

# CLOUD CATCHER

England

A fruit infusion of cherry, sour cherry, kiwi, coconut and apple pieces. This infusion provides an exceptionally fruity flavoured brew with sweet and tangy flavours. Can be enjoyed hot or as a cold infusion.

# SUN CATCHER

England

A fruit infusion of blood orange, apple and hibiscus, it has a sweet and tangy flavour. Can be enjoyed hot or as a cold infusion.

# CHAMOMILE

Egypt

An infusion made from Egyptian grown chamomile flowers. It has a full-bodied flavour and is known for its curative properties.
